**STUDY SESSION:**

**A. KETTLEMAN CITY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS:**

The Board held a study session focused on proposed KCES site improvement projects. Dr. East presented proposed plans for the Kettleman City Elementary School fields and parking area. He explained that shade structures and parking lots will require ADA access to administration buildings and fire alarm upgrades. The Board and audience conducted a walkthrough to the proposed project areas. After much discussion, the Board directed the Superintendent to extend the soccer field north beyond the existing fence line. They would like to add two more sets of lights and shift the field and proposed walking path north. The Board would like to make a rubberized walking path a priority. They also proposed the shade structure be placed west of the basketball courts.
